

Academic Tutoring


- tutoring the student in choosing modules, projects etc.
- main responsibility: teacher
- supporters: Other universities and Teacher Education
- College and development projects
- supervisor: Head of the Programme

Support for Personal Growth

- guiding the Student to know himself in special situations (study difficulties, attitude and health problems)
- main responsibility: councellor

- main responsibility: offices, library and student tutors
