- Jyskänvuoren tehtaitten ammattikoulu, nowadays known as Industrial Learing Space Ltd was founded by Valmet Corporation in Jyväskylä in 1946.
- At that time there was a strong need to have vocational education for a large number of new employees.
- Our experience: 60 years of vocational education in close co-operation with industry.

 - Valmet, later renamed to Metso Paper
- Owner structure since 1999
 - Metso Paper Ltd
 - Metso personnel fund
 - Jyväskylän University of Applied Sciences (Politechnic)
 - Jyväskylä vocational education joint municipal authority



Industrial Learning Space Ltd

Our operations are divided into three sectors:

- Vocational education
- Personnel training
- Subcontracting machine shop

Net sales 2006 (also costs) exceed 4 M€, about which over 0,2 M€ is support from the government.



- Formally we arrange preparatory training for competence-based qualification.
 Qualifications are Finnish competence-based qualifications in three level:
 - vocational upper secondary qualification
 - further vocational qualification
 - specialist vocational qualification
- We educate professionals:
 - plater-welder / welder
 - machinist
 - mechanical fitter



- Annually about 50 persons start studies.
 - We face some lack of suitable persons for further vocational qualification.
- Our students are working for us
 - Wages are around 1.200 1.300 € / month.
 - This is a workplace not traditional school.
 - All students are over 18 years old.
 - Right attitude and work motivation are the most important issues.



- Time frame for studies
 - vocational upper secondary qualification 2 years
 - About 3 months theory
 - Majority of time practice, real work
 - further vocational qualification 1,5 years
 - Nearly 2 months theory
 - Majority of time practice, real work
 - specialist vocational qualification 2 years
 - About 2 days / month theory,
 - A lot of remote work
 - Majority of time in own workplace



- During the studies students are already in practical training in metal companies.
- After the studies all plater-welders / welders, machinists and mechanical fitters are recruited by metal and mechanical engineering companies.
- Demand for professionals is bigger than what we can supply.



- Vocational education
 - New employees for Metso Paper
- Personnel training
 - "Home trainer" for Metso Paper
- Machine shop
 - Single supplier for certain components and a large number of case by case components.



- Vocational education New employees for Metso Paper
 - Metso Paper recruits machinists and mechanical fitters from us.
 - Metso Paper's own groups, at the moment own export mechanical fitter education.
 - Career opportunities between Industrial Learning
 Space and Metso
 - Specialist Qualification for Machinists further training for very experienced machinists.



- Personnel training Home trainer for Metso Paper
 - We train according to the customers' needs
 - Middle management, sales and material management training programs
 - Product knowledge training
 - Language teaching in all Metso Paper's Finnish units
 - Work safety



- Machine shop Single supplier for certain components and a large number of case by case components.
 - Single supplier for paper machine's doctors' bearing and bearing housing, steam- and condensate pipes
 - Spare parts for Metso Paper service
 - A large number of demanding case by case components, eg different components for pilot paper machine and very demanding welding works

 - Moventas recruits machinists and mechanical fitters from us.

- Personnel training various training according the needs
 - We train according to the customers' needs
 - Project management
 - IT-training
 - Language training

Industry and commerce educational institutes

- 42 industry and commerce education institutes operating in Finland
- Institutes are own by major corporations fully or partially, funds, other schools and institutes and various authorities
- Institutes serve owners or industry in question depending on the background of the institute.



Industry and commerce educational institutes

- Institutes are operation in various fields, eg.:
 - Metal industry (5 institutes)
 - Paper industry (2 institutes)
 - Retail business (several)
 - Insurance business (several)
 - Aviation (1 large institute)
 - Finance (several)



Industry and commerce educational institutes

- Total annual costs about 160 M€
- Government supports annually about 25 M€.
- 250.000 persons in training every year
