

- 1981 National Council for Educational and Vocational Guidance (consultation & policy development & systems development; publishing company)
- 2004 National Dialogue Forum for Educational and Vocational Guidance (dialogue)
- + 2008 National Council for Adult Guidance (consultation)

## **DK Forum Members (2004)**

- Approx 25 appointed members
- Representing social partners, ministries (education, labour, integration), students' associations, guidance professionals' associations, municipalities, etc (4 years)
- 11 personal members (2 years)
- Secretariat: Min of Education
- Chairperson: Min of Education

## Meetings

- 3-4 yearly plenary meetings
- Sub committees on e.g. quality assurance, target groups, competencies of guidance professionals, lifelong guidance, etc
- + informal meetings 😳

## SWOT
