ISSUES FOR TG2 (SI, GR, CZ, A, DK, PL)

- Exploitation of the results of EU funded projects are lower than expected
- Challenge: How to increase the effectiveness and efficiency of invested resources

The need to increase exploitation of results and synergy among projects

CRITERIA FOR 'POLICY RELEVANT PROJECT'

What are criteria for 'example of good project' from policy perspective?

- Synergy with other projects
- Exploitation of the results

For past projects some kind of impact on guidance policy is needed

REVIEW OF GUIDANCE PROJECTS

- We reviewed guidance projects financed from various programmes: LLL (LDV), Progress (DG Employment), ESF
- We analysed them from policy perspective
- We analysed them in relation to four priorities
- We selected examples/projects of good practices

FINDINGS

- We identified a number of projects which meet criteria – projects with strong link to guidance policy (within countries included in TG2)
- Projects can be linked to four priorities (to one or more priorities)
- All programmes are relevant (LLL, ESF, etc.)
- Examples described in the ELGPN Synthesis r.

RECOMMENDATIONS 1

To commissioners

Develop effective procedures to prevent ‘reinventing the wheel’, duplication and overlapping of projects

To national guidance forums

- Link projects with national priorities
- Encourage ministries to provide co-funding for projects which are dealing with priorities
- Proactively encourage synergies between proj.

RECOMMENDATIONS 2

Enhance cooperation with EUROGUIDANCE

- E.G. to maintain the database of policy relevant guidance projects (follow up)
- Inform and support national guidance forums
- Promote work of ELGPN and successful projects through their existing communication channels

RECOMMENDATIONS 3


To project coordinators
