Youth on the move (Lead DG EAC)

1. Developing modern education and training systems
2. Promoting the attractiveness of higher education
3. Supporting the attractiveness of transnational learning and **employment mobility for young people** (DG EMPL) = EURES
4. **A framework for youth employment** (DG EMPL)
 - Help to get a first job and start a career -
 - Support youth at risk – Youth guarantee
 - Provide adequate social safety nets
 - Support young entrepreneurs and self-employment
