- Career and Guidance Psychology studies play an important role at the Faculty of Psychology (University of Lisbon).
- Lead role of Faculty of Psychology in the implementation of the Educational and Guidance Psychology Services (SPO) at schools in the 80's
- Since then an important role in the training of psychologists in this domain

Topics: Assessment perspectives in career counseling across the lifespan; Qualitative and quantitative assessment methods

- **Practice and Master Dissertations**

- In the second year of the Master Course students have a practice experience in a professional setting (30 ECTS). The master dissertation is an empirical research work that is developed also in the second year of the Master Course (18 ECTS).
