## WHAT AND WHY IS CMS CATALOGUE/INVENTORY?

"CMS overview in Europe – CMS catalogue/inventory"

CMS catalogue/inventory is a list of themes/topics (with items organised around set of categories) from which ELGPN countries could choose in order to develop their own CMS frameworks in respect to national context (curricular tradition, educational and labour market sectors, other).

Data analysis and structuring	January - May 2012
Developing the final document of CMS catalogue/inventory	June -September 2012
